

# Diagnoses, Medication Lists, and ICD-10 codes to accompany IVD-2 and PREV-13 for GPRO 2018

## IVD-2: Ischemic Vascular Disease (IVD)

Patients who were discharged alive for acute myocardial infarction (AMI), coronary artery bypass graft (CABG) or percutaneous coronary interventions (PCI) in 2017 or 2018 should be included in the measure.

*Possible ICD-10 dx codes: I20.X, I24.X, I25.X, I63.X, I65.X, I66.X, I70.X, I74.X, I75.X*

- Angina, unstable or unspecified
- Atherosclerosis of coronary arteries or arteries of extremities
- Stroke (CVA), transient ischemic attack (TIA), or other cerebral infarction due to ASCVD in 2017 or 2018
- Claudication
- Ischemic cardiomyopathy
- Acute or chronic ischemic heart disease
- Acute coronary thrombosis
- Occlusion and stenosis of cerebral, carotid, or vertebral arteries
- Embolism and thrombosis of abdominal aorta or other arteries
- Atheroembolism (any site)

*Denominator Exclusion if patient is on any of the following medications:*

 Bivalirudin(Angiomax)  
 Dabigatran(Pradaxa)  
 Dalteparin(Fragmin)  
 Desirudin(Iprivask)  
 Edoxaban(Savaysa)

 Heparin  
 Lepirudin(Refludan)  
 Rivaroxaban(Xarelto)  
 Tinzaparin(Innohep)  
 Warfarin(Coumadin, Jantoven)

*\* The diagnosis of Peripheral Vascular Disease (PVD) and/or Peripheral Arterial Disease (PAD) would not be considered confirmation of a diagnosis of IVD.*

## PREV-13: Atherosclerotic cardiovascular disease (ASCVD)

Diagnosis of ASCVD can be active or history of anytime through the end of 2018.

Potential ICD-10 dx codes: I20.X, I23.X, I25.X, G45.X, G46.X, I63.X, I69.X, I70.X

- Acute coronary syndromes
- History of myocardial infarction
- Stable or unstable angina
- Coronary or other arterial revascularization
- Stroke or transient ischemic attack (TIA)
- Peripheral arterial disease of atherosclerotic origin

*Denominator Exclusion if patient has any of the following current diagnoses:*

Pregnancy  
Breastfeeding  
Rhabdomyolysis
